

This survey is conducted during the month of July to September and results of this survey were declared in the month of November. The objective of this survey is to classify the Professional institutes under three categories: Platinum for highest, Gold for Medium, Silver for Lowest level of Industry -Institute Interactions. This survey is conducted in two phases: Short Survey and Full Survey. For survey we need to submit the data and upload relevant documents as a proof in the AICTE - CII Portal under various parameters like:

- 1. Governance: Participation of Industry People in the Institute Governance.
- 2. Curriculum: Like Industry Visits, Industry Expert Talk, MoUs with Industries etc.
- 3. Faculty: Training of Staff by the industry experts and by faculty for the industry people, patents by Faculties and Students.
- 4. Infrastructure and labs developed by Industries in the institute.
- 5. Services/Project & Skill Development Program with industries
- 6. Placement of students
