3. Brief about Camp:

Department of MCA has organized free eye checkup activity under social camps and surveillance. An eye examination is carried out by an optometrist and usually takes about 20-30 minutes. Sometimes it can take longer if you need extra tests, but this is to make sure that whatever you are having some eye problem or not.

As well as testing the sight, the optometrist will check the health of the eyes and look for signs of general health problems.

At the start of the eye examination, the optometrist will ask why you are having the eyes examined, whether it is a routine check-up or if you have come for a specific reason.

If you are experiencing problems with the eyes or vision the optometrist will need to know what symptoms you have, how long you have had them and whether any changes have happened suddenly or slowly over a period of time.

The optometrist will also need to know about the general health including any medication you are taking, whether you suffer from headaches, or have any close relatives with a history of eye problems.

While examining the eyes will be examined both outside and inside. This will allow the optometrist to assess the health of the eyes and may identify any other underlying medical problems.

The interior of the eye will be examined using an ophthalmoscope, a special torch which shines a light through the pupil allowing a detailed study of the internal structures. The pupil reflexes will also be tested.

In this test following categories are examined:

- Vision
- Eye movements and co-ordination
- Choosing glasses or contact lenses

After the eye examination, the optometrist will now have detailed knowledge of the health of the eyes, the standard of the vision and any special requirements that you may have. Don't be afraid to ask questions if there is something you don't understand; the optometrist is there to help.

If you need medical treatment for an eye condition you may be referred to the doctor or hospital.
